

Directions for SOAR Angel Bags



These directions are for novice seamstresses. If you want to do it on your own, that's terrific.

Material: Can be plain, print, etc. Muslin, cotton, or any sturdy fabric will do. (2 colors or kinds can even be used for one bag.)

Finished size: **Width 12 inches**
Length 17 inches

Cording or ribbon to pull in the top of the bag 1 yard per bag.

The finished size may vary up to 2 inches if you need to adjust to get more bags out of your material.

Sew the sides and bottom together with $\frac{5}{8}$ " seams. Turn the top over $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches. I lay the cording on top of the material on the wrong side and turn the top over and sew the cording in it so I don't have to run the cord through the casing. The cording will just come out of the bottom of the top casing, or you can sew $\frac{1}{2}$ in the seam, skip $\frac{1}{2}$ inch for cord to come through and then sew the rest of the side. If you do it this way, you do this only on one side of the bag and then turn it over as above and the cord will come out of the middle of the casing.
