- 10. Don't try to speak the local language; you'll look foolish.
  - 9. Don't eat any of the local food; be sure to bring your own.
  - 8. The trip is all about you and your team having a great time and building memories; so stay focused only on your team.
  - 7. Go where and when you want; don't worry about an invitation you're a blessing!
  - 6. Do what you think best; remember... you're a blessing and Americans are in charge!
- 5. Be sure that your commitment to comfort is greater than your commitment to serve.
- 4. Stay organized and on schedule at all times!
- 3. Keep narrowly focused on "spiritual" activities; don't worry about the "unimportant" work.
- 2. Help the nationals, the missionaries and your teammates by quickly pointing out their mistakes.
- 1. Don't worry about advance planning, preparation and administration.

You may think some of these "Don'ts" sound silly. You may think you would never say/do that. But honestly, sometimes it's hard to stay focused especially when you're in unfamiliar territory. It's good to be reminded how to be a good guest and teammate before we get on the mission site instead of after we've blundered our way into offending someone.
